
VENUE

The European Congress will take place at the Adyar Theatre (4 Square Rapp, 75007), next to the HQ of the TS France, in the centre of Paris, near the Eiffel Tower.



REGISTRATION

Registration fees for the Congress are:

- for members 20 euros,
- for non-members 30 euros. The last date to register to the European Congress is 15 May 2014.
