The establishment of the Theosophical centre in the Balkans

After a cycle of activities at the Center for Human Ecology (over 20 years), creating the conditions for the establishment of the Theosophical center in Serbia, which could cover the area of the Balkans (Southeastern Europe).

It is the result of polyvalent, pioneering involvement with several stages, and domains of action. On projects have participated individuals and groups, spiritual teachers, lecturers and associates, mainly from Serbia (some from former Yugoslavia and Ukraine). The activities were conducted mainly on the route Belgrade - Balkan mountains (the border area between Serbia and Bulgaria).

The principles and aspects of the activities

- principles of the authentic Theosophy as a platform of engagement (implicit and explicit)
- systematic study of worldwide primary literature in the domain of spirituality references: Teosofija, Advaita Vedanta, Theravada Buddhism, Esoteric Christianity (Daskalos) own sites: www.agarta-enklava.com, www.budizam.info and books¹
- •Theosophical principle of pluralism of the world's spiritual heritage (Knowledge, practices)
- attendance meditation courses/seminars (personal choice teachings and spiritual paths/practice)
- principled balance of complete an Knowledge and effective spiritual practice (meditation)
- ·application of acquired knowledge, moral codes and principles of practice in everyday life

Sectors of the prior engagement

- · organizing of regional summer camps/seminars, local retreats and common meditations²
- · construction of the own pavilion at the Balkan mountain
- the establishment of the Theosophical Society of Serbia (as the crown of the prior engagement)
- internal seminar (local teosophical community): The Secret Doctrine H.P.B. (thematic sessions)

Plan of the current engagement (for the next few years):

- networking and cooperation with Teosophical Society and centers in Europe and the world
- · completion of the construction and furnishing of the pavilion at the Balkan mountain
- the establishment of the Regional Theosophical Centre (RTC) in the pavilion, with two sectors:
 Theosophical Research Centre
 Comprehensive Retreat Centre
- mission and basic activities of the RTC:
 - affirmation and the revival of the Theosophical movement in the region of Southeast Europe³
 - forming of internal library; translation and editing of theosophical literature, publishing
 - organizing summer camps and retreats; creating the conditions for a stationary stay ("ashram")
 - servicing the local and regional community of meditators (wider range of teachings, trails and practice)
