The journey

The approach to *The Voice of the Silence* will be an integrated one. This means not a line-by-line nor word-by-word approach, from the beginning of the First Fragment to the end of the Third Fragment.

The seminar is based on the idea of the Path, taking texts from all three fragments and making a whole of it. In the end most of the texts in the *VOS* will have been addressed.

The idea is to see ourselves as the Path and on the Path, at the same time trekking alone but with karmicsocial responsibilities towards fellow travellers and to nature.

It is a comprehensive understanding and meditation on the Path that will lead us to a better realization of who we are, where we are on the Path, and what barriers and obstacles we face (internal and external). It is a view of how the conscious or unconscious karmic choices we make dictate or affect the life that will lead to the goal.

To complement and reinforce what we find in the text of the VOS, there will be references to teachings from other books and articles of H.P. Blavatsky, *The Mahatma Letters*, and other traditions like Plato, *The Egyptian Book of the Dead*, amongst others.

For example: in *The Book of the Dead* we find the soul on its journey to Amenti (Devachan) or to another field leading to union with the Divine (Nirvana).

The soul must go through *the seven portals* (analogous to the seven paramitas) and face obstacles.
